

AUSTRALIAN CITIZENSHIP CEREMONY DRESS CODE

In accordance with the Australian Citizenship Ceremonies Code, all Australian Councils are required to enforce a Dress Code for Citizenship Ceremonies.

A Citizenship Ceremony is a formal and meaningful occasion conducted with dignity, respect and ceremony. Due to the nature of the ceremonies, it is important that citizenship recipients wear attire which reflects the significance of the occasion.

Permitted:

Smart casual attire National or Cultural Dress

Not Permitted: Jeans, board shorts or thongs Peak caps
