



Working with a small business financial counsellor and what to expect.


YOUR FIRST APPOINTMENT

 3. agree to work together


ADDRESS IMMEDIATE CONCERNS

 5. assistance with accessing government assistance packages and programs


CLARIFY YOUR POSITION
