

SkillsBuilder 2020

SkillsBuilder 2020 is a program designed specifically for Year 11 and 12 students living and studying in the North West of Tasmania.

The program is funded by the Australian Government under the Industry Training Hub initiative. It offers a new partnership between the Burnie Industry Training Hub and TasTAFE, that aims to assist students in building a range of key employ-ability skills to ensure they are job-ready and well-equipped to work in local industry areas.

Developed to improve employment opportunities and vocational pathways in seven key skill shortage industry sectors, the program consists of custom-designed skill sets that employers in the North West are looking for.

The seven 2020 SkillsBuilder programs are:

- SkillsBuilder Disability (starting 10 November 2020)
- SkillsBuilder Civil Construction (starting 17 November 2020)
- SkillsBuilder Manufacturing (starting 16 November 20202)

Aussie Backyard Bird Count

Thank you to all the Citizen Scientists who recorded data during National Bird Week (19-25 October) for the <u>Aussie Backyard Bird Count</u>. Nationally 5,050,399 birds were counted.

This year for postcode 7310 together we:

- Submitted 187 Checklists
- · Recorded 97 Species, and
- Sighted 4,408 birds!

That is an amazing effort! This data assists <u>BirdLife Australia</u> the nation's largest conservation organisation. It gives them information about the common species that live where people live. Providing snapshot of Australian birds at the same time each year allows Birdlife Australia to look at the trends in our bird communities from year to year.


