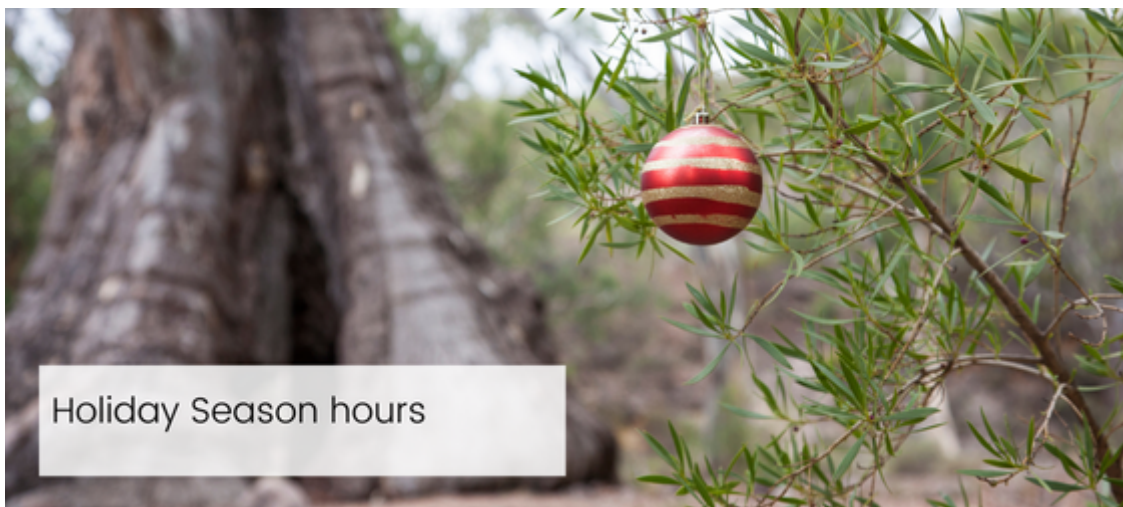

Where: Aikenhead Point (along Victoria Parade/Bluff Road, across from the Bass Strait Maritime Centre).

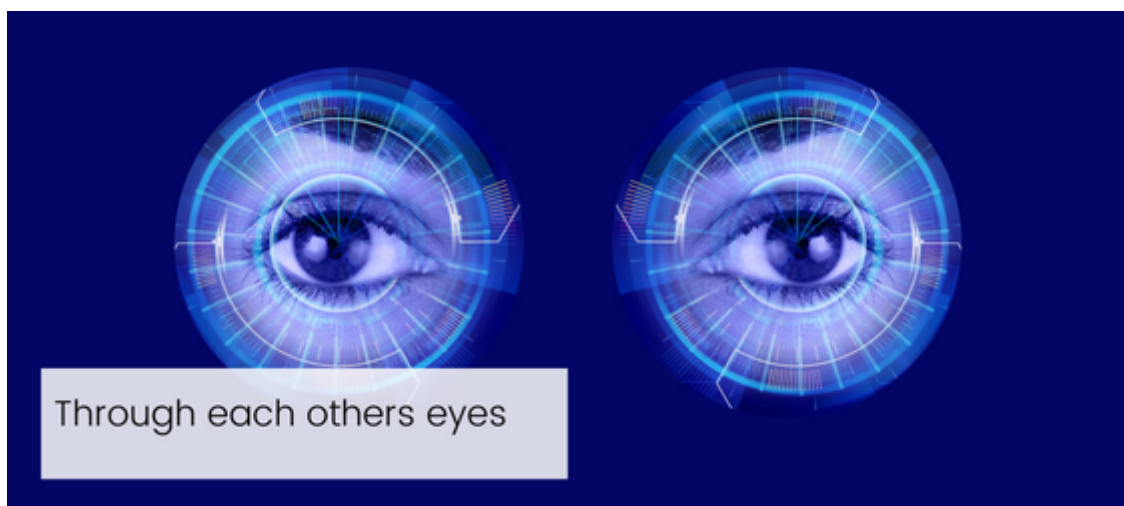
Cost: Free

Small Grants Program

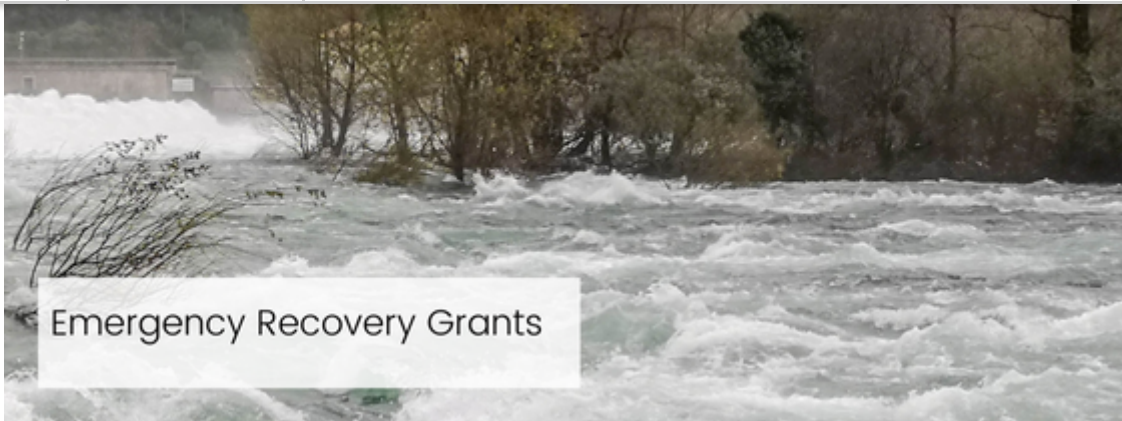
2023 Highways and Byways Small Grants Program

Grants up to \$4,000 will be available for practical environmental restoration and rehabilitation projects, and community-focused initiatives that encourage community re-connection and strengthening post-pandemic.

Applications open on Wednesday 1 February and close at 5pm AEDT on Wednesday 15 March 2023.

Non-Profit Organisations - Emergency Recovery Grants

Funds are available under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements to assist with the costs of clean-up and reinstatement of non-profit Devonport organisations that have suffered direct damage as a direct result of the severe weather event in October 2022.

This grant is intended to assist non-profit organisations to continue or re-commence operations as soon as possible where the impact has been severe.

Available Funding

The maximum grant amount available to any one organisation is \$25,000.

- An initial one-off amount of \$2,500 (Tier 1)
- A subsequent one-off amount of up to \$22,500 (Tier 2)

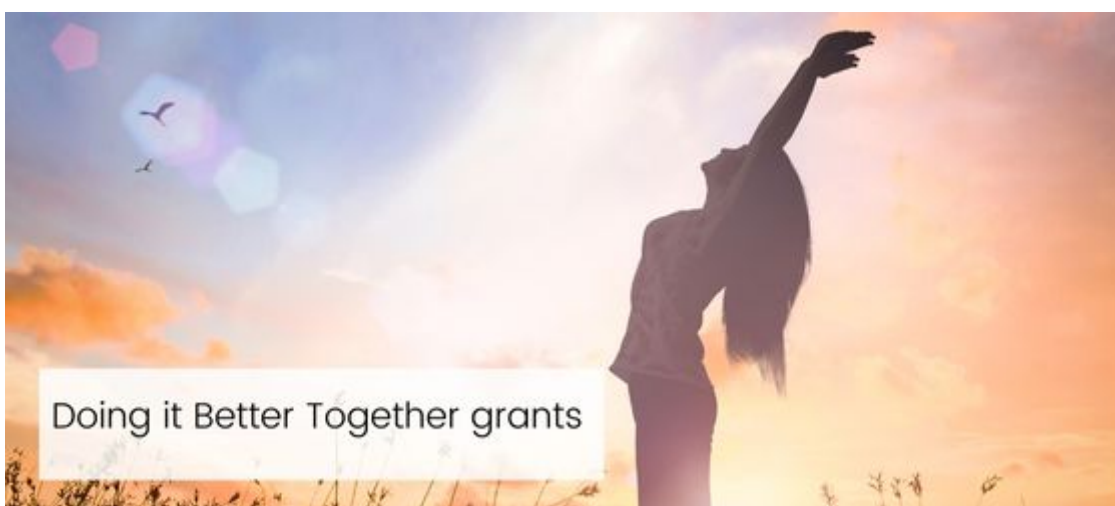
Grants are available in three categories:

- innovation project grants of up to \$100,000 (ex GST) for innovative projects for community organisations to deliver significant harm prevention and early intervention projects
- community project grants of up to \$30,000 (ex GST) for community projects to support community organisations to provide services to their communities
- small equipment grants of up to \$5,000 (ex GST) for equipment to support community organisations.

Round 5 of the Doing it Better Together grants are now open. \$3,000 is available to eligible community groups wanting to run initiatives to support positive mental health and wellbeing in the Burnie, Central Coast and/or Devonport local government areas. 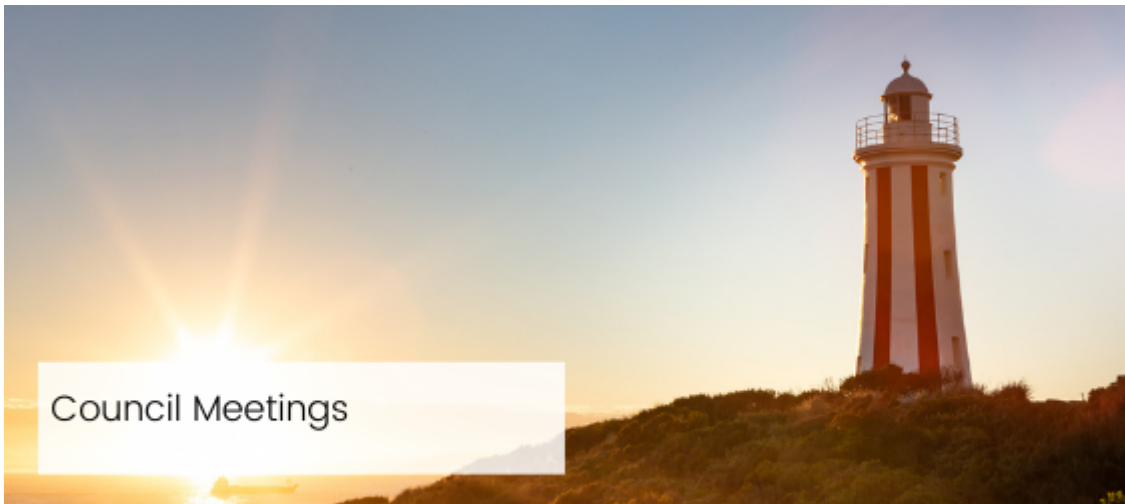
