A message from the Devonport City Council Natural Resource Management Officer

Winter is the wet season in our region and is the perfect time to plant native plants in your garden.

Natives are a better alternative to exotic plants, as they are more adapted to our soils and climate and are less damaging to our environment if their seeds escape our yards.




