Devonport City Council provides a waste collection service for eligible people with disabilities. If you are unable to take your wheelie bin to the kerbside or you don't have someone living with you who is capable of putting your wheelie bin out, you may be eligible for this service.

## Waste Collection Services for People with Disabilities

**Guidelines for qualified health care professional:** This is a special service to cater for persons with severe disability or injury where the driver of the waste collection vehicle will enter the applicant's site on foot to collect, empty and return the wheelie bin/s. For applicants to be eligible for this service, their condition must be severe and one or more of the following must apply:

- Unable to manage steps or uneven ground without the use of a complex walking aid or cannot walk a distance of 50 metres without having to rest due to pain;
- Have major difficulty with steps and inclines; and/or
- Totally dependent on others for mobility;
- Have sensory disability vision impairment;
- Unable to wheel a wheelie bin to the kerb in front of their residence and back.
